His clear position is such conditions is further attested to by his letter to one of his friends years later, when the dread disease struck Vilna a second time: "Everything has its season, and every purpose a time' — At this time, when malady has made its appearance in the land, and G-d protect us, even here — Now this is what one must do, and it stands to reason, not to be afraid of it at all — for what is man's life in any case, and who knows whether his path is right; also to take care to follow doctor's instructions, since even according to our faith we are bound to be guided by their words, and to assume the yoke of living in this world, for (the sake of) Him Who is good and does good. Now it was our experience in the past when the disease was most intense, G-d protect us, that whoever undertook to observe (lit. "Bent his shoulder to bear the yoke") the conduct imposed by the doctors in eating..., wisely and not foolishly, was not affected by any disease or illness, G-d protect us. Since in a time like this, according to the law, all religious practice is changed therefore one must not be excessively sorrowful on the Holy Days, and it is the time to observe and serve G-d in joy, and this is our protection."
