

# NJIHoF Annual Awards Banquet

Location Wesley J. Howe Center – Stevens Campus



## Directions if you are driving from New Jersey:

There are two main routes into Hoboken, the Stevens Web site suggests approaching campus from Weehawken, near the entrance to the **Lincoln Tunnel**. Take the NJ Turnpike (I-95) South to the Lincoln Tunnel (I-495) Exit. Follow signs towards the Lincoln Tunnel and exit before the tunnel at the "Last Exit In New Jersey, Weehawken, Hoboken" . Turn right at the second traffic light, this places you Southbound on Park Avenue. Follow signs to Hoboken. Continue over the land bridge into Hoboken and make a left at 14th Street, turn right onto Washington Street. Make a left on 9th Street and continue through the campus gates the traffic circle in front of the Howe Center (13-story building). Valet parking attendants will be waiting.

An alternative route that goes near the entrance to the **Holland Tunnel**. Take 1&9 or the NJ Turnpike toward the Holland Tunnel. As you come down the ramp make the first left at the light onto Jersey Ave. Turn left at the light on Jersey Ave (Exxon station diagonally across the road from you). Follow the road under the RR tracks and go right on Observer Highway, proceeding alongside of the RR tracks to Washington St. After about 1 mile, go left on Washington Street and proceed to 9th Street. Make a right on 9<sup>th</sup> Street continue through the campus gates the traffic circle in front of the Howe Center (13-story building). Valet parking attendants will be waiting for you.

If you are being dropping off (via cab, etc.) proceed along Washington to 9th street, turn right onto 9th, and continue through the campus gates the traffic circle in front of the Howe Center (13-story building). The entrance to the building as it at the circle.

If driving, you may want to allow a few minutes for delays because of commuter traffic backed up at the entrances to the Lincoln and Holland tunnels, especially in the evening (at least 20 minutes in the morning).

## Directions for public transportation:

Your best option for reaching Stevens Institute of Technology is using public transportation. From New York, take the PATH train or the New York Waterways shuttle to Hoboken. From New Jersey, take NJ Transit to Hoboken. From the train station/shuttle stop, walk north on River Street for about 10 minutes.

(Alternatively you can walk along the river front, one block east of River Street, with a breathtaking view of Manhattan across the river.) Once you walk through the park, you are on campus. Make a right, at the Babbio building (the new glass building on the right) after the MacLean Chemical Building. Go through the parking area and through the gates and head up to the Wesley J. Howe Center Building. Alternatively you can take a taxi, which are \$5.00 from the PATH station.
