Good Evening Everyone, I apologize for not attending this Senate meeting

The Cabinet met earlier this week to make sure the elections and budgeting process is on the right track. I am also working on scheduling a SGA retreat this summer, most likely in early August. When the current bylaws were put in place it worked out to have roughly \$20 out of every persons Student Activity Fee be put into the CIF, unlike the original plan of \$15. I would like to drop that back down to \$15 and put the increased free directly into the Student Activity Fund, so the money can be spent on the clubs and activities going on that semester at Stevens.
