



## Stevens Institute of Technology's **FIRST** Scholarship

In support of the FIRST mission, Stevens Institute of Technology is offering two merit-based scholarships, each for \$6,000, to high school seniors who have participated on a FIRST team during their junior or senior year. This scholarship may be utilized by students planning to study engineering, science or math at Stevens Institute of Technology. The scholarship is renewable up to a total of \$24,000 over four years, contingent upon maintaining good academic standing. Each recipient must meet the regular academic requirements for admission to the university.

### **Eligibility**

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a senior in high school
- Have participated at least one full season during your junior or senior year on a FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) team or a FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC) team
- Apply and be admitted to Stevens Institute of Technology as a full time student. (However, you do not need to have already been admitted at the time you apply for this scholarship.)

### **Application Requirements**

To apply for the Stevens Institute of Technology *FIRST* Scholarship, complete the application package, including:

- A completed Stevens Institute of Technology *FIRST* Scholarship Application
- A 500+ word essay regarding your *FIRST* experience and your career goals
- A letter of recommendation from an adult mentor/coach on your *FIRST* team
