- Shoes, sneakers, boots, rain boots
- Umbrella
- Bathrobe, slippers
- Shower shoes, shower caddy
- Toiletries
- Vacuum cleaner/broom
- Clothes hangers
- Desk lamp (no halogen)
- Dry eraser board
- Laundry bag, laundry basket, detergent
- Sewing kit
- Plastic eating utensils
- Small can opener, bottle opener
- Fan
- First-aid kit
- Back pack
- Bicycle, bicycle lock
- Money, debit card
- Room décor, standing lamp
- Snacks and drinks
- Refillable water bottle

Restricted Items
