



CARNEGIE ACES STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIPS SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Carnegie ACES Study Abroad Scholarship fund is established to provide financial support to undergraduate STEM students from underserved communities that have financial need and wish to pursue a virtual international experience. Students who are receiving university funding for virtual study abroad opportunities (i.e. Pinnacle or Clark summer funding) are not eligible.

- **Use of Funds:** Awards are intended to assist with virtual international internships. Awards will be disbursed only after the student has demonstrated a financial commitment to the Virtual Internship Program (e.g. paying a non-refundable deposit). A student who does not fully participate in the program for which the award was provided will be required to reimburse the Fund.
- **Awards:** Scholarship awards to eligible students are subject to availability of funds. Students with “high financial need”, as determined by the Office of Financial Aid, may be awarded an additional amount subject to availability of funds.
- **Donor acknowledgement:** Awardees are *required* to provide a report to the Office of Development describing how the International Program benefited their education and *may* be asked to make a presentation to a donor(s) as an acknowledgement of their support.
